At a Glance

Boltcargo coordinated a multi-origin logistics chain to bring a diverse fleet of vehicles and heavy machinery into Angola. Sourcing spanned seven countries across three continents, with cargo consolidated, shipped, and cleared before final inland delivery to project sites and depots across Angola, including Viana.

Scope of Work

Boltcargo's scope covered the full chain of custody for a varied fleet of vehicles and machinery — from origin sourcing and export documentation through ocean freight, port handling, and final inland delivery across Angola.

Key Aspects

- Coordination of multi-origin sourcing and export clearance across Mongolia, China, India, the Netherlands, Brazil, Madagascar, and Cameroon
- Consolidation of mixed cargo — ambulances, pickup trucks, water tankers, truck chassis, and excavators — for efficient onward shipment
- Ocean freight coordination and port handling on arrival in Angola
- Inland transport via flatbed and low-loader trailers to depots and project sites, including Viana
- Loading and securing of wheeled and tracked cargo using chains, ratchet straps, and purpose-built load frames
- Convoy coordination and on-site supervision for oversized and multi-unit loads

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Execution & Transport Strategy

Each cargo category presented distinct handling requirements — from securing wheeled vehicles for road transit to managing the asymmetric weight distribution of tracked excavators. Boltcargo's teams adapted loading methods and trailer types to suit each consignment.
